

# CORRECT WHEELIE BIN USAGE

*To ensure your wheelie bin is collected each week, please follow the instructions below:*

## DO

- Recycle all you can
- Place bin within 1 metre of the kerb, with the lid opening facing the street
- Place bin at least 2 metres from any structures or vehicles
- Make bins available for easy access by Council Waste Collection trucks
- Bins to be placed on kerbside by 6.00am on collection day
- Where more than 1 bin, space 1 metre apart
- Ensure lid is closed and no rubbish is overflowing
- Bag all loose rubbish (e.g. dust, bottles, kitchen scraps)
- Retrieve bin as soon as possible after collection
- Wash bin regularly



## DON'T

- Overload bin (make sure lid is fully closed)
- No Green waste
- No bricks, rock, soil or concrete
- No large metal objects (metal can be recycled)
- No liquids – paint, motor oil or solvents (oil & paint can be recycled)
- No toxic or corrosive substances
- No batteries
- Block pedestrians or vehicles
- No fluorescent tubes or mercury lamps
- No hot materials (ash)

*Failure to adhere to these instructions may result in your bin not being serviced.*
