COMMUNITY CALLED TO MEET ABOUT NEW DAM EMERGENCY WARNING SYSTEM

SunWater, operator of the Callide and Kroombit dams, is encouraging Biloela residents and the broader community to attend a briefing on a new dam emergency warning system.

The new system is designed to alert residents living downstream of Callide and Kroombit Dams in the highly unlikely event of a dam failure.

At the briefing, SunWater will explain the operation of a new siren system and the evacuation procedures required.

The system will include a siren adjacent to the water storage tank on Earlsfield Street, a siren on Linkes Road as well as electronic 'Road Subject to Flooding' signs on Linkes Road, adjacent to Callide Creek.

The new dam emergency warning system would only sound in the highly unlikely event of a dam failure, indicating that residents should proceed to Banana Shire Council's nominated assembly point, the Biloela Civic Centre on Rainbow St.
