Location: Biloela Council Chambers, 62 Valentine Plains Road, Biloela, QLD, 4715

Distance: 3 kilometres

Cost: \$10 per dog. All proceeds will go to the National Breast Cancer Foundation.

There will be plenty of activities including; jumping castle, face painting, and a dog obstacle course. Test your skills on the obstacle course and see how well you can communicate with your dog.

There will be a sausage sizzle breakfast after the walk and a coffee van and ice cream van operating.

Dogs of all shapes and sizes are welcome. All dogs must be social and must be on a leash.

Please wear pink! Either just a splash or an all-out over the top ensemble, the more pink the better!

There will be prizes awarded on the day for the following: the best dressed dog, the best dressed person, the best dressed couple (person and dog), and the dog that looks most like its owner.
