### **SCOPE**

All urban, rural residential and industrial precincts in Banana Shire whether on land under Council control or privately owned premises.

#### **OBJECTIVE**

- To define Council's role in providing and maintaining the entrances to towns and estates, limited to the designated urban, rural residential and industrial precincts.
- Ensure the entry features are low maintenance, aesthetically pleasing and appropriate; and
- Ensure the safety of pedestrian and vehicle traffic is not compromised.

Council retains the right to nominate a theme for entrance features.

Council is under no obligation to maintain any estate entrance feature.

Council reserves the right to maintain, modify or remove an entrance feature on a road reserve at its discretion notwithstanding that Council approval has previously been given.

Council accepts no responsibility to maintain an entrance feature within a private property, notwithstanding that Council approval has previously been given.

Removal of an entrance feature may be enforced by Council should it be deemed necessary for safety or aesthetic reasons notwithstanding that Council approval has previously been given.

This Policy is to be read in conjunction with Council's Street Plantings Policy and Standard Drawing CMDG-G-016.

#### **PROCEDURE**

As approved and issued by the Chief Executive Officer and subject to future revision, amendment and issue under the authority of the Chief Executive Officer.
