Section 1 Scope of Works

1.1 Overview of Project Objectives

Banana Shire is a thriving rural shire situated on Central Queensland. The shire's administration centre is located at Biloela, approximately 120 km west of Gladstone. Proposed work is in Taroom about 200kms from Biloela in Leichhardt highway.

Taroom water supply source is an artesian Bore located in the town itself and water is directly feeding to the storage tank on artesian pressure. The existing bore head shown in figure is not comply with the minimum bore head construction shown in Fig 2. Therefore, the existing bore head need to modify and connect to the existing delivery pipes, which need some modification to the pipe work.

1.2 **Brief Description of the Works & Scop**


The existing bore head shown in the Fig 1 need to be removed and install a new bore head similar to the picture shown in Fig 2. This modification will change the height of the delivery pipe and need some modifications to the existing delivery pipes for the connection. This Consultancy work is for taking field measurements and preparing a CAD drawing for a suitable bore head with dimension for fabrication of a bore head and pipe specials and making a drawing with a slandered pipe specials to connect new bore head to existing rising main.

A detailed work scope for this consultancy is included in section 1.3. Also refer Table 1 for detailed price schedule required for tendering for consideration by Council.

SCOPE

Banana Shire council is planning to replace the existing Bore head in Taroom water supply scheme shown in Fig 1

Therefore, Consultants are advised to submit the pricing for preparation of drawings, and schedule of material and cost estimate for replacement of existing bore head shown in the Fig1. The work will be carried out by council reticulation staff in 2022/2023 budget. Following are some of the works to be carried out by the consultants.

- Take the site measurements/ Dimension sand levels of existing pipe work.
- Prepare a suitable drawing for new bore head with the dimensions for fabrication and prepare a drawing for connecting pipes to the existing rising main.
- Prepare a list of material for purchase and installation work by the council staff with a suitable contractor.




