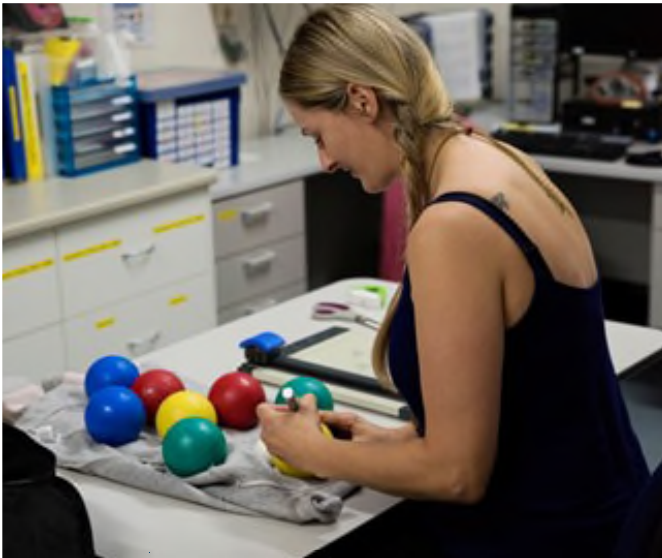
MEMBERSHIP

INDIVIDUALS, GROUPS OR ORGANISATIONS

Are eligible for membership if they:

- Work in the area of health or education
- Work with referred members/clients
- Require access to facilities/resources to enhance the service delivery to people with identified needs.

Groups include but are not limited to:

- Residential Aged Care Facilities
- Support Organisations



SCHOOL MEMBERSHIP

Entitles all teaching staff to:

- FREE membership

NB: Individuals, Groups or Organisations are not eligible for membership if their primary activity:

- Involves commercial enterprise
- Does not involve supporting those with an identified physical, intellectual, social or psychological need.
