FLOAT PARADE REGISTRATION FORM

Participants are to assemble at the Qld Heritage Park, 11 Exhibition Ave, Biloela Qld 4715, via Burnett Highway entrance by 9am. Entry available from 7am Sunday 6 October 2024. If entry is required earlier, direct consultation with Qld Heritage Park will be required.

Burnett Highway entrance is to be used only by those driving the vehicle used as a float. All other participants must enter via the Qld Heritage Park main entrance.

Participants travelling on floats must not access the float until stationary at the assembly area. The parade will progress around a designated parade course within the Qld Heritage Park grounds. Floats will be free to leave the grounds once the parade is over at approximately 10.30am. All floats must vacate the Qld Heritage Park grounds by 3pm.

Parade Rules & Regulations

ENTRANTS

- Instructions of Biloela Centenary Advisory Committee organisers and QLD Heritage Park representatives (Parade Co-ordinators) are to be always followed.
- Possession of, or consumption of alcoholic drinks is prohibited.
- All entrants and vehicles/floats entering the parade must be registered with the Biloela Centenary Advisory Committee.
- No promotional materials/sweets are to be handed out.
- No unrestrained livestock will be permitted in the parade.
- Each entrant must have a list of all the people participating in the parade and written consent (Participant Indemnity Form) must be given by the parent/guardian of any child under 16 years of age. This must be submitted with the registration form by COB 23 September 2024.

VEHICLES/FLOATS

- All vehicles/floats must be roadworthy and registered with either normal road or club registration.
- All vehicles/floats must be comprehensively insured or hold third party insurance at a minimum (in case of incident at the event). Vehicle/Float owners must provide a certificate of currency for the current insurance policy along with this registration form by COB 23 September 2024.
- All vehicles/floats must always remain below 10kph and maintain a safe distance (a minimum of 5metres) from other vehicles/floats with no overtaking permitted.
- All vehicles/floats are to keep to the centre of the road where possible.
- All vehicles/floats must be operated in a safe manner (all wheels must stay on the ground).
- All vehicles/floats are to follow the route set out by the Parade Co-ordinators.
- All props must be secure on all vehicles/floats.
- All participants riding in/on vehicles/floats must always be seated.
- No objects are to be thrown or tossed from any vehicle/float or by any participant while participating in the parade, whether riding in/on the vehicle/float or walking alongside.
- Do not encourage or entice children or parade spectators onto the parade route.
- No participants shall get on or off a moving vehicle/float.

CHILDREN

- All children under 16 years of age must have written consent from a parent/guardian (Participant Indemnity Form). This must be submitted with the registration form by COB 23 September 2024.
- Children under 16 years of age, whether in/on or walking alongside the vehicle/float must be under the supervision of a responsible adult.
- Children are not permitted to ride bicycles or scooters in the parade.

In submitting this Registration Form, I declare that all information supplied on behalf of the business/organisation/entrant is correct at the date of this application. I have read and understood the rules and regulations of application and agree to abide by them.
